### **Summer 2018 Scholarship Application**

Kate's Camp for Kids is pleased to be able to offer this financial aid program. The Scholarship Fund is funded by grants, special events, and individual contributions. Most awards do not exceed 50% of tuition and are based on family income.

**FUNDS ARE DISPENSED ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS WHILE AVAILABLE.**

To be considered, an applicant must:

- 1) Show a financial need;
  - a) All applicants must complete an application and supply all requested documentation at the time the application is submitted. You may use one application for more than one child in the same family, but you must provide all requested information for each child. Your application will not be considered if incomplete.
  - b) Applicants must submit a letter (to be written by either parent or student) explaining the value of this scholarship to them and their interest in the camp program.
  
- 2) Demonstrate a serious commitment to arts education;
  - a) If funds are awarded, students will be expected to adhere to the policies outlined in the CMS Policy Handbook. At the discretion of Community Music School and The Kate, the scholarship may be revoked for policy violations and you will be held responsible for tuition balances. Cases of extended illness will be handled on an individual basis.
  
- 3) Demonstrate a serious commitment to the program.
  - a) All scholarship recipients are encouraged to participate in the performance that is part of the program for which the student is enrolled.

5. All students must adhere to the Community Music School's policies as outlined in the 2017-2018 Policy Handbook.
6. At the discretion of Community Music School and The Kate, the scholarship may be revoked for policy violations and you will be held responsible for tuition balances.
